

BELVOIR DRIVE NO WAITING AT ANY TIME PARKING RESTRICTIONS

15 metres of double yellow lines no waiting at any time parking restrictions (shown in green on the plan) were introduced on either side of Belvoir Drive at its junction with Aylestone Road, under and the Leicester (Belvoir Drive)(Experimental) Traffic Order 2019. These restrictions replaced existing single yellow line no waiting Monday to Saturday, 7.30am – 6pm, parking restrictions that were previously marked to 14 metres on this part of Belvoir Drive.

The restrictions are to help ensure that this junction is kept clear of parked vehicles at all times and is in response to concerns raised by the Ward Councillor about congestion at the junction caused by visitors to the Leicester City Football Club training ground.

The double yellow line restrictions have been in operation for over 12 months and the City Council has continued to monitor the site to determine how they affect traffic movements at this junction.

The City Council has not received any objections to making the experimental proposals continue in force indefinitely during that time, and has therefore decided to make the restrictions permanent by way of amendment to the Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order (2006).

The formal reason for introducing these restrictions is for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
