

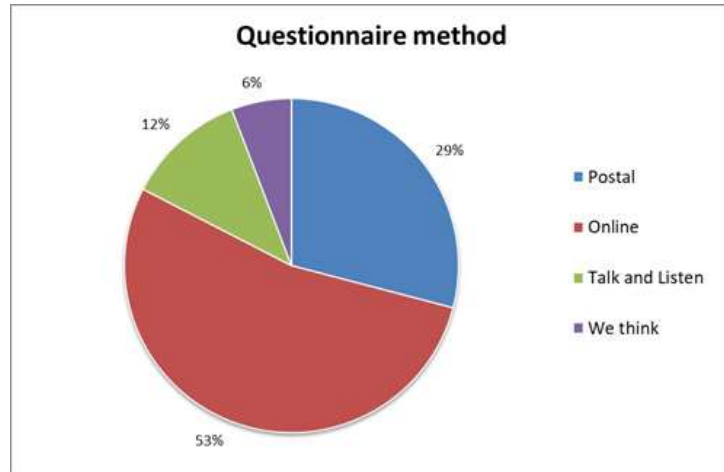

OVER 125 people contributed to the consultation

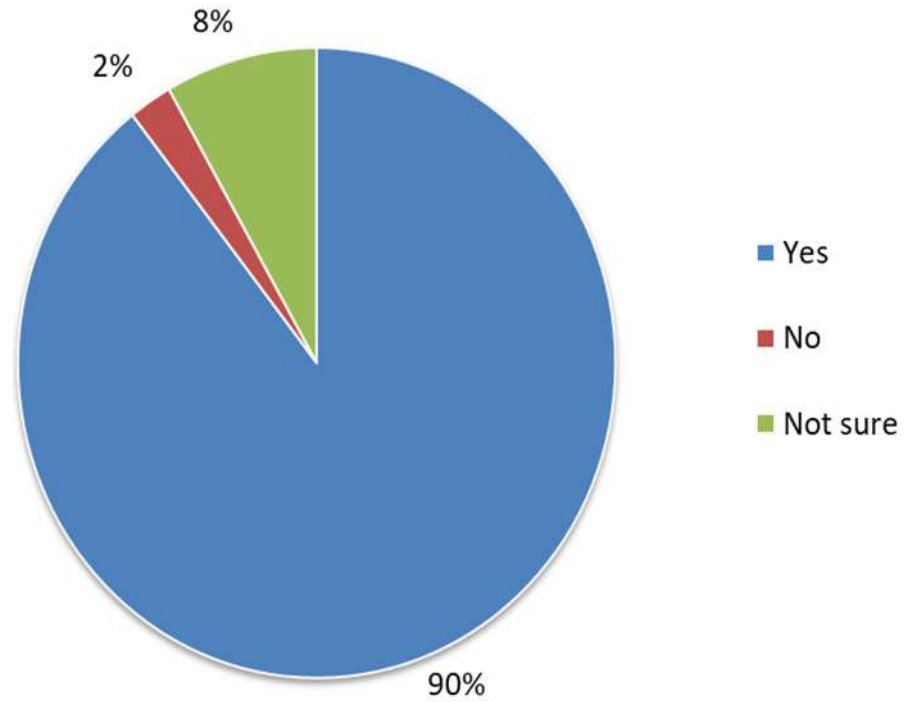

Do you agree with what we say about social care?



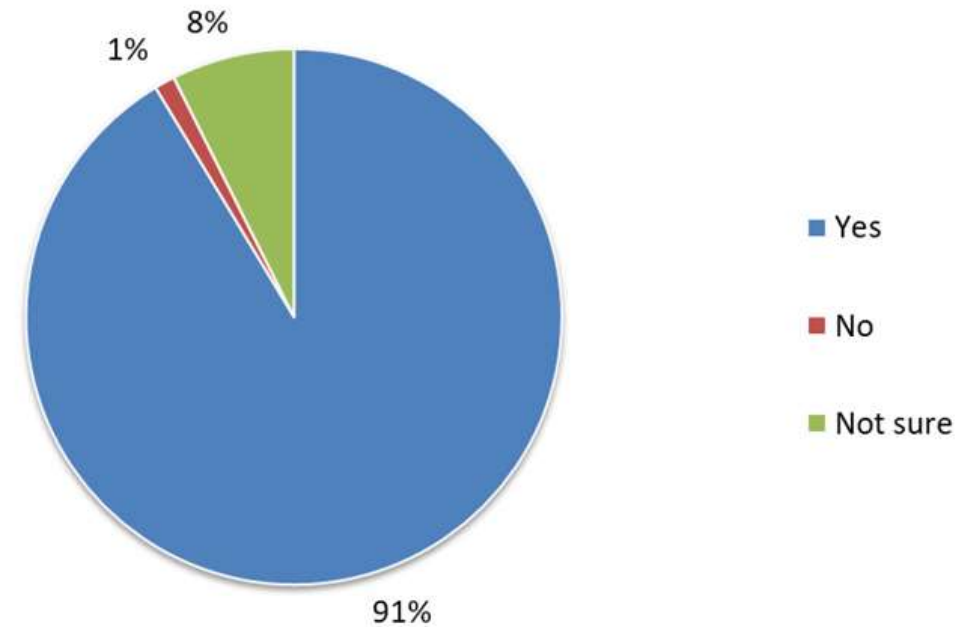
Housing and accommodation

Do you agree with what we say about housing and accommodation?



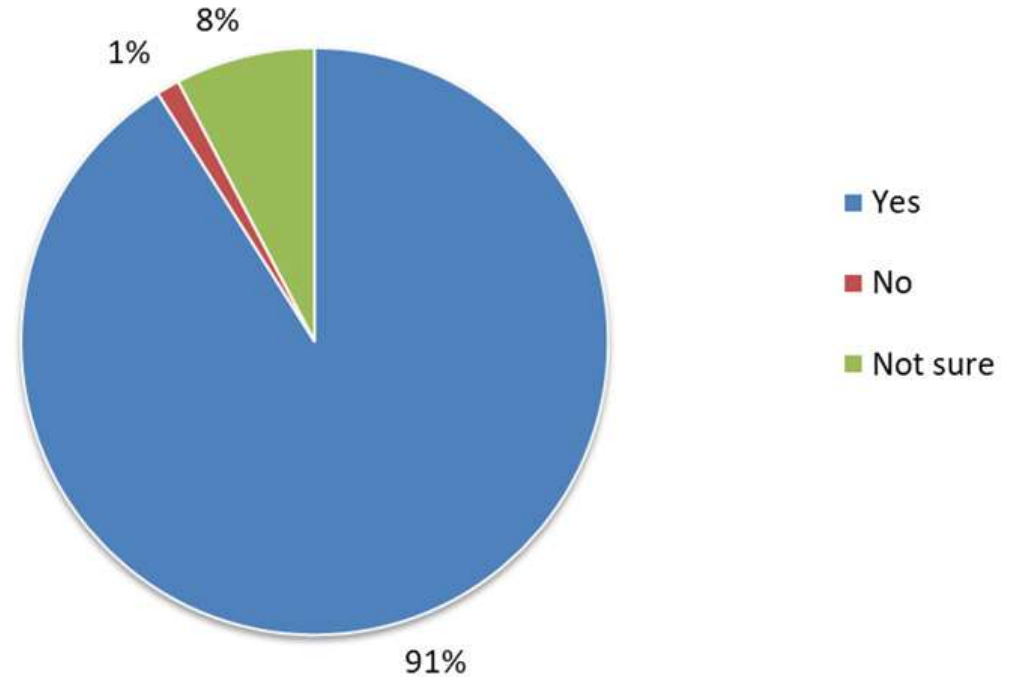
Equal healthcare

Do you agree with what we say about equal healthcare?



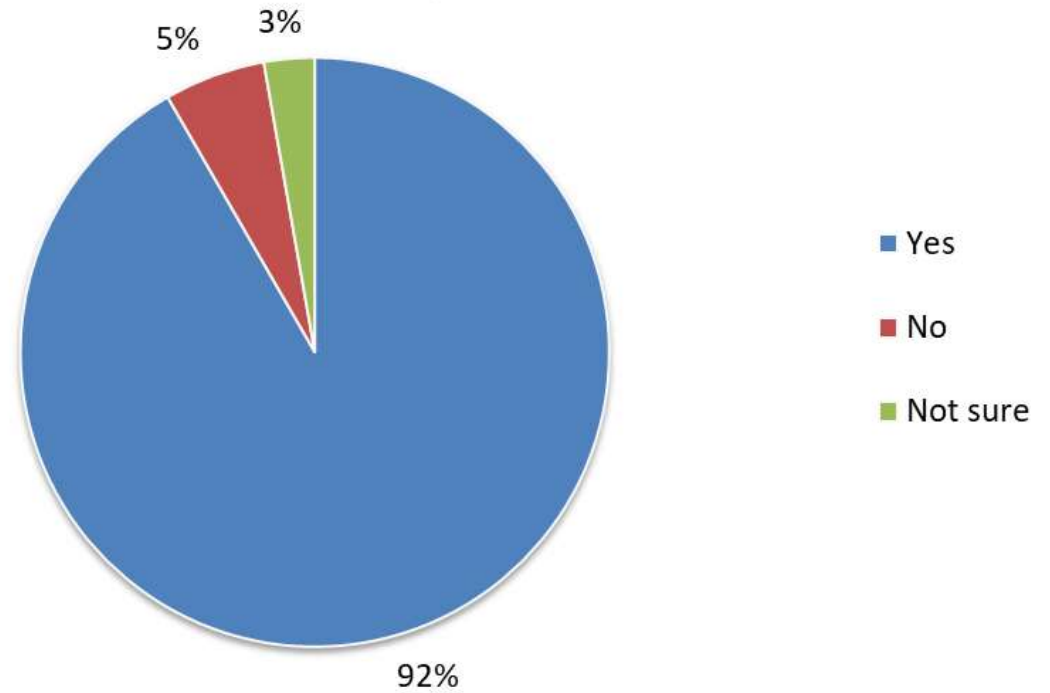
Healthy Lifestyles

Do you agree with what we say about healthy lifestyles?



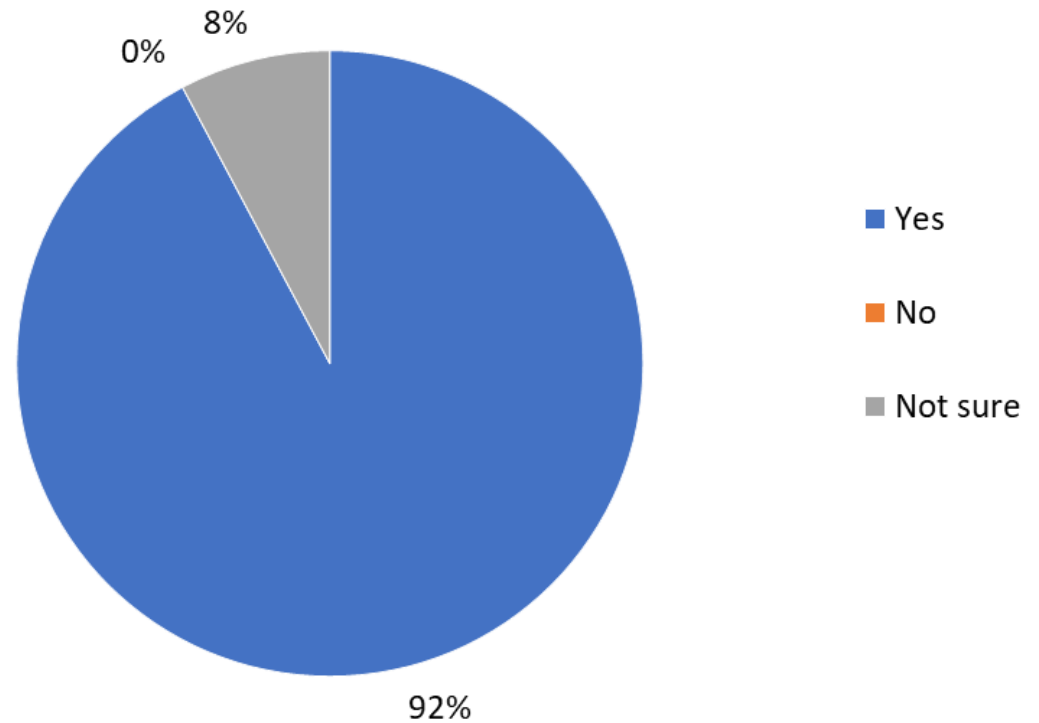
Work / College and money

Do you agree with what we say about work, college and money?



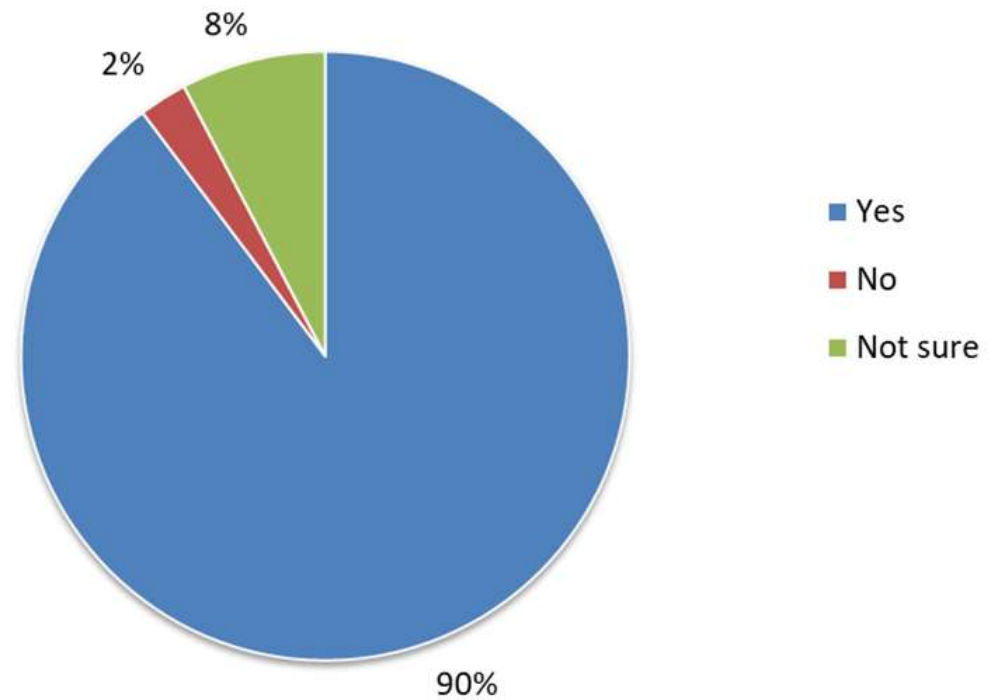
Becoming an adult

Do you agree with what we say about moving to adulthood?



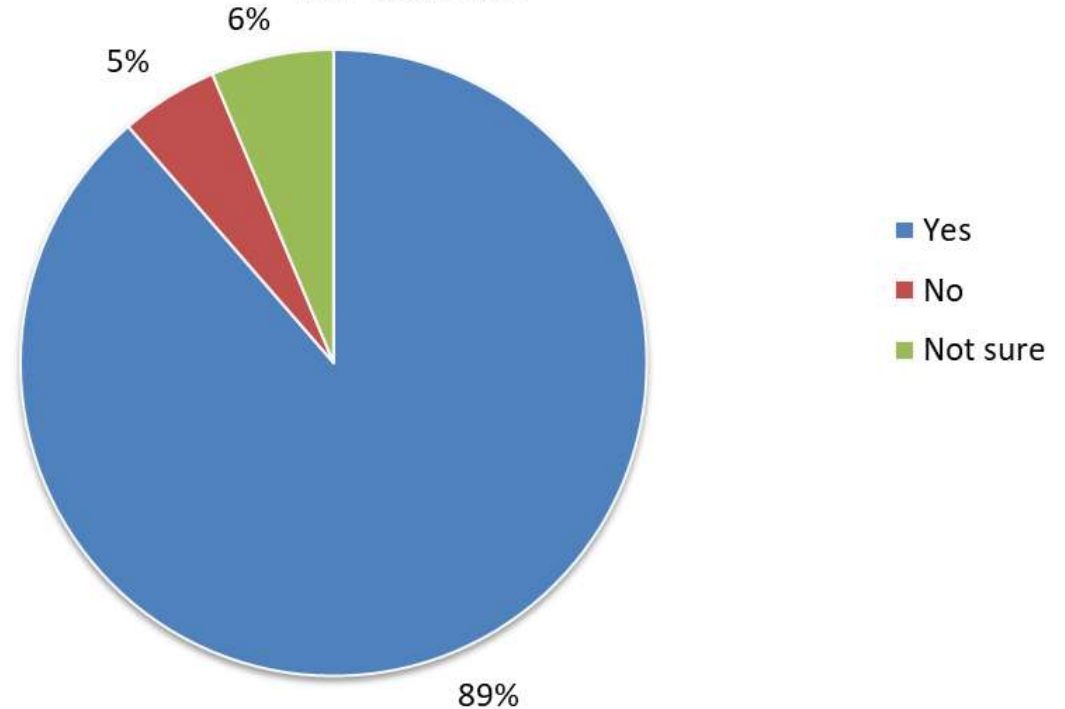
Family carers and unpaid carers

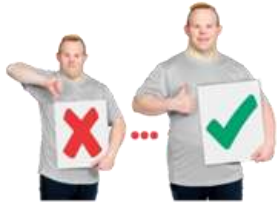
Meetings

- Every person needs to get the same level of service






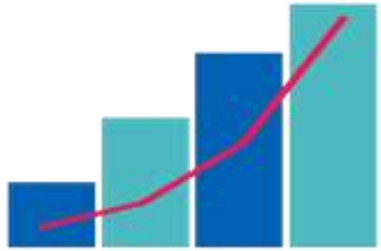
- It must to be easier for people with a learning disability to say when they are not happy about something
